## **Scavenger Hunt Color Sort**



Materials:

- 1 bag of Pom Poms/stickers (to get you started/practice)
- 1 construction paper sheet of each rainbow color
- 1 glue stick
- tape
- 1 marker
- 1. Place construction paper sheets out on a flat surface
- 2. Write the name of each color at the top of the construction paper sheet.
- 3. Sort Pom Poms/stickers from baggie by color to get started
- 4. Begin your scavenger hunt by searching your house for items/objects that match the colored sheets and place them in your brown bag. (TIP: Make sure these items are small enough to fit on the sheet and is okay for your child to grab and possibly tape or glue to the sheet)
- 5. When your bag is half full/full, begin sorting your objects on your construction sheet mats one by one. **Optional: Glue down each object as you sort it.**
- 6. Starting with your red sheet, count all the objects you've collected/sorted and write the number in word form, color word in the bottom right corner, (i.e., seven red).
