## Sensory Box Activity



Materials Intro: For today's activity, you will need:

- Pencil case (plastic w/lid)
- 1 quart baggie w/ black or red beans
- Small letters 1-26
- Small numbers 1-9

Note: You can use various materials to create different sensory bins (beans, dry noodles, rice, etc.) and insert pictures, objects with the same initial sounds and numbers!

1. Pour $1-2$ cups of dry red/black beans into an empty pencil case with a lid
2. Take the bag of small letters and place them in different parts of the bin
3. Seal the pencil case and shake it up! (be gentle it might open if you shake too hard)
4. Open your sensory bin and begin searching for the letters of the alphabet
a. When you find a letter, say its name and the sound it makes
5. Place all of your letters in order off to the side once you've found them all and practice your ABC's!
